

Getting to Killarney

Killarney is situated on the south-west coast of Ireland in Co Kerry. There is a train service from Dublin (Heuston Station Dublin to Killarney daily).

AIRPORTS

Kerry airport – no direct flights to the US. Flights from the UK and Dublin. Twenty minutes from conference venue.

Shannon airport – direct flights to the US.

Approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes drive to conference venue.

Dublin Airport – direct flights to the US.

Approximately 4.5 hours drive to conference venue.

Train – trains from Dublin city to Killarney, see timetable at www.irishrail.ie.
