Dr. Holloway graduated cum laude from The Ohio State University College of Dentistry in 1990. She then completed the three-year Advanced Prosthodontics graduate program at Ohio State and received her Master's of Science degree. She joined the faculty at Ohio State in 1993 and directed the graduate residency program in advanced prosthodontics from 2004-2011, first as associate director then director. She currently directs the graduate residency program in advanced prosthodontics at The University of Iowa and serves as the Department of Prosthodontics Departmental

Executive Officer (Head). She maintains an intramural practice limited to prosthodontics, with emphasis on ceramic and implant restorations.

Dr. Holloway's research foci are in the materials sciences, primarily porcelain strengthening mechanisms and the fatigue fracture mechanics of dental implant materials. She has received the 2011 Clinician/Researcher Award from the American College of Prosthodontists, and several teaching and research awards from The Ohio State University College of Dentistry. She is presently the President of the Carl O. Boucher Prosthodontic Conference and President-Elect of The American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics. She is an active Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists and an Associate Fellow of the Academy of Prosthodontics.
