J. Robert Kelly teaches graduate prosthodontics and biomaterials and is Director, Center for Advanced Technology Integration at the University of Connecticut Health Center. His academic credentials include the D.D.S., an M.S. in dental materials science, the D.Med.Sc. in oral biology and a Certificate in prosthodontics. He has served on the Council on Scientific Affairs of the American Dental Association (ADA), is Convener of the International Standardization Organization working group responsible for dental ceramics, Vice Chairman of the ADA Standards Committee on Dental Products and President, American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics. Dr. Kelly has received awards for biomedical research (Harvard), research and post-graduate education (Assoc. Military Surgeons of the U.S.) and as a clinician/scholar (Amer. College of Prosthodontists). He has contributed to dental, engineering, and medical literature, holds eight patents, frequently lectures before national and international dental and engineering organizations, still does some of his own porcelain and keeps his fingers wet practicing prosthodontics.
