STEPHEN F. ROSENSTIEL, BDS, MSD

Stephen F. Rosenstiel B.D.S., M.S.D. is Professor of Restorative Dentistry at The Ohio State University College of Dentistry, where he maintains an intramural prosthodontic practice. He is a 1973 dental graduate of Birmingham University in England and completed his Masters in Prosthodontics at Indiana University in 1977. He taught fixed prosthodontics and occlusion at the University of Florida and University of London before joining Ohio State in 1985. He was President of the American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics in 2010-2011 and past president of the Prosthodontics Group of the International Association for Dental Research, the John F. Johnston Society for Advanced Prosthodontics and the Fixed Prosthodontic Section, American Dental Education Association for Dental Schools. He is Associate Editor of the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry and serves on the editorial boards of the Journal of Dentistry, and Prosthetic Dentistry Review. He is an author of the textbook Contemporary Fixed Prosthodontics, the fourth edition of which was published in 2006. The textbook has sold over 50,000 copies, is used in many dental schools and has been translated into eight languages. He has authored over 180 scientific articles and abstracts, principally on the fracture properties of dental ceramics and dental esthetics.
