

Dr. Doug Phillips is currently serving his sixth year as the Treasurer and Secretary for Guests for the American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics. Dr. Hai Zhang is a Professor in the Department of Restorative Dentistry and Director of Competency Assessment in the School of Dentistry, University of Washington. He earned a PhD in Oral Biology and a Certificate in Prosthodontics from the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine in 2002. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and a Fellow in the American College of Prosthodontists (ACP).

Dr. Zhang is proud to be a member of the American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics (AAFP) and has served in the Tylman Research Committee as a member and the current Chair. He is also the vice Chair of the Research Committee of the ACP.
