9:00 Parker E. Mahan, D.D.S., Ph.D. Full time teaching and research; Associate Professor of Dentistry, Emory University.

"Structure and Function in the Stomognathic System"

In this lecture a number of anatomical features of the temporomandibular joint and mouth will be discussed and related to their function. The anatomy of the normal TMJ will be correlated with the various movements of the joint in functional and non-functional jaw positions. The anatomy of selected head and neck muscles and their activity which moves the mandible will be discussed and all of these subjects will be related to diagnosis and treatment planning.

10:00 Edward P. Klecinic, C.D.R., D.C., U.S.N. Head of Partial Denture Division, Naval Dental School, National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Md. Diplomate, American Board of Prosthodontics, Fixed Partial Dentures.

"Periodontium and Fixed Partial Dentures"

The presentation will stress the importance of adequate preparation of the supporting tissues and the surrounding areas, prior to the placement of a Fixed Prosthesis. Three distinct methods for the correction of soft tissue contours will be shown. Overall emphasis will be on the continued health of the periodontium.

"The Elderly Patient Who Needs Crown and Bridge Prosthodontics"

A study of factors involved in geriatric oral rehabilitation bodily and oral aging changes, emotional integrity and the physiologic tolerance of the oral tissues. Before the Crown and Bridge Prosthodontist begins technical procedures, he is obligated to obtain a biologic knowledge of the tissues into which, and upon which, he plans to place his prosthesis and he must understand the totality of the person of whom those tissues are a part.
