Several variables can mechanically affect graphic tracings of mandibular movements. These variables were studied, on patient, utilizing pantographic tracings.

Styli positions, vertical dimension changes and tooth guidance can affect pantographic tracings.

This study suggests that functional optimum occlusion should be in harmony with border tracings.

The Golden Staple is used primarily for the stabilization of periodontally involved teeth. Its use is compatible with direct and indirect technique, and may also be used for certain types of bridge repairs.
