PRESIDENTIAL BIOGRAPHY



STEPHEN D. CAMPBELL DDS, MS

PRESIDENT, AAFP 2000-2001

Dr. Stephen D. Campbell was born on July 6, 1951 in Van Nuys, CA. He attended Medical College of Virginia from 1975-79 where he was the recipient of several scholarship awards for academic excellence. He achieved a Certificate in Prosthodontics from Harvard School of Dental Medicine, Boston, MA in 1982 with a simultaneous MMSc through course work in Biomaterials at Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Dr. Campbell's teaching affiliations include Clinical Instructor in Prosthetic Dentistry at Harvard School of Dental Medicine (1982-1986), Research Associate at Forsyth dental Center (1984-92), Assistant Professor of Prosthetic Dentistry (1986-90) then Associate Professor of Restorative Dentistry with Tenure at the University of Illinois at Chicago (1992-present).

He has extensive clinical experience including part-time from (1979-1982) and the practice of Prosthodontics (27 hours per week (1982-1993) and (12 hours per week from (1993) till the present (2009). He is also presently Director of the Comprehensive Dental Implant Center at UI at Chicago.

Dr. Campbell's lecture experience include over 200 invited lectures given to major local, state, and national prosthodontic societies and courtesy lectures to many Prosthodontic Graduate Programs. His primary topics have been on Clinical Fixed Prosthodontics, Evidence Based Practice, Dental Ceramics, Dental Implant Care and Research.

Steve has been active in dental research throughout his career having been the principal investigator for several NIH grants healing with dental ceramics. He has authored or co-authored over 50 abstracts published in the Journal of Dental Research and Journal of Dental Education and published over 35 articles in the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, Journal of Prosthodontics and the International Journal of Prosthodontics.

His honors and awards are too numerous (over 25 listed) to include them all. They progressed through the Dean's list (MCV 1973) OKU (1979), Harvard Distinguished Faculty Award (1990), Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics (ABP 1990), International College of Dentists (1998) and the American Academy of Prosthodontic's George H. Moulton Award in 2007.

Dr. Campbell has been President of the IADR Prosthodontic Group (2000-01), American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics (2000-01), American Board of Prosthodontics (2005-06), American College of Prosthodontists (2006-07), Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontists (2008-09), and Academy of Prosthodontists (2008-09).
