

AMERICAN ACADEMY OF CROWN AND BRIDGE PRESIDENTIAL BIOGRAPHY

EARL ALLEN NELSON, DDS PRESIDENT, AACB 1955-1956

Dr. Earl A. Nelson was a graduate of the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry around 1920. Most all of the dental faculty members appointed during those times were UMSD graduates who taught parttime while conducting private practices. Earl was no exception. He was appointed to the Crown and Bridge faculty in 1921 while maintaining a practice in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Nelson served on the UMSD faculty from 1921 to 1952 and was on leave from 1952 to 1955 to conduct research on dental castings without salary. He was a professional lecturer at the school from 1955 to 1957. His place of practice was listed as the Medical Arts Building in Minneapolis, MN in the American Academy of Crown and Bridge Roster of 1967-68. No other information was forthcoming from the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry archives.
