Dr. Vermilyea received his DMD from the University of Oregon Dental School in 1971, an MS in Dental Materials from the University of Michigan in 1976, and a certificate in Prosthodontics from Walter Reed Army Medical Center in 1985. He was board certified in 1986. As member of the U.S. Army Dental Corps, Dr. Vermilyea served as a General Dental Officer, Research Dental Officer, Chief (Division of

Dental Materials, U.S. Army Institute of Dental Research), Prosthodontist and Deputy Commander (U.S. Army Dental Activity, Panama), and co-Director, Advanced Education in Prosthodontics (Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington, D.C.). He retired after 21 years at the rank of Colonel in 1992 and joined the faculty at The Ohio State University College of Dentistry. During his time at the University, he served as an Assistant Professor Prosthodontist, tenured Associate Professor, Chair of the Section of Primary Care, and finally, Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs. He retired from the University in December of 2011. He currently serves as an examiner for The Commission on Dental Competency Assessments (CDCA). He has lectured nationally and internationally and has multiple publications on dental materials and prosthodontics in peer reviewed journals.
