Dr. Sarit Kaplan is a graduate of the Hebrew University, Hadassah School of Medicine in Jerusalem, Israel, where her interest in prosthodontics started. She practiced as a general dentist for a few years, until starting the post graduate program in prosthodontics at the University of Maryland where she earned a certificate in prosthodontics and a master's degree in oral biology. Following graduation from the prosthodontic program, Dr. Kaplan

joined a group practice in Bethesda, Maryland and served as a parttime clinical assistant professor in both the undergraduate program and postgraduate prosthodontics program. She became a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics a few years later while raising her children, developing her private practice and continuing with her passion to teach prosthodontics. Dr. Kaplan has been an active member in many local and national dental organization and has served on their board of directors and different committees and has served as a past president of the Maryland ACP section.

Dr. Sarit Kaplan has been a member of the American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics since 2010 and has been a very active member in the academy, including chairing the Poster Presentation Program for 6 years, chairing the Scientific Program in 2023 and on the board of directors of the academy.
